
3. The claims would be entertained as per the revised procedure vide this Ministry's letter No.RW/G-20011/2/2001-WA dated 12.4.2001.

5. This sanction issues with the concurrence of Finance Wing vide their U.O. No. 752/TF.II dated 13.11.2019.


