

The Authorised Signatory, AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd., vide letter cited under reference (4) has submitted the proposal for laying of Gas Pipeline in the stretch fromKm 351/000 to Km 355/500 on LHS, from km 352/100 to Km 352/500 on RHS for a length of 4900 mts & 407mm steel casing pipelilne across NH 44 at 02 nos. of locations from LHS to RHS for a length of 120 mts(total length of 5020 mts) of Hyderabad - Bangalore Section of NH 44 and sought the approval.

- In this regard, it is to inform that the Chief Operating Officer, NHLML vide letter 2. no. 1655 dtd 17.03.2023, vide which the agency M/s Sterlite Technologies Limited was appointed and instructed to take up the OFC project in the utility corridor on LHS of the subject stretch. Further, the agency, IBI Group India Pvt Ltd. has been appointed as Authority Engineer for supervision of said project.
- In this connection, keeping in view of proposed OFC duct on LHS of the proposed 3. site. AG&P has informed that the proposed Gas pipeline will be laid within 0.8mts width from extreme edge of ROW by leaving a width of 1.2 mts (out of total available 2.0 mts of utility corridor on LHS) for laying of OFC duct without disturbing the same.
- As such, this office vide letter cited under reference 3rd above has requested the 4. Six laning DPR Consultant, Supervision Consultant of the subject stretch&AE appointed for OFC Duct work to examine the complete proposal of the AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd., and the recommendation of the Consultants on the proposal may please be communicated by duly signing the drawings/checklist submitted by AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd., & keeping in view all the standard conditions issued vide Ministry / NHAI Circulars.

5. The proposal to be considered is as under.

6. Following particulars are furnished by the Applicant with the proposal.

- 7. In this connection, AE& Contractor of the OFC duct work vide their mail dtd 29.02.2024has informed that they will execute the laying of OFC within an offset of 29 mts from the center line of ROW. As such, based on their input, the AG&P has propsoed to lay pipeline with a depth of 2.5m and in extreme width of ROW (i.e., within an offset of 29-30 mts) by maintaining sufficient gap between the other utilities.
- 8. Further, DPR Consultant vide their letter no.8829 dtd 28.02.2024 &Supervision Consultant vide their letter no.53 dtd 04.03.2024 informed that their team has inspected the above said locations and reviewed the documents submitted by the AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd.,and verified all the points in accordance with the Ministry Guidelines RW/NH-33044/29/2015/S&R dtd 22.11.2016 and communicated certain observations on the proposal. Accordingly, the applicant was instructed to submit revised documents as per the observations.
- 9. Based on the observations, the applicant has submitted revised documents duly satisfying the site conditions and the same were verified & found in order. The brief details of the proposed work is as below,
 - (i) AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd., submitted their proposal for laying of Gas supply Pipeline. The locations of the proposal along the NH-44 are from Km 351/000 to Km 355/500 on LHS, from km 352/100 to Km 352/500 on RHS for a length of 4900 mts & 407mm steel casing pipelilne across NH 44 at 02 nos. of locations from LHS to RHS for a length of 120 mts (total length of 5020 mts).
 - (ii) The ROW details as per available records are 60 mts.

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- (iii) The agency submitted the necessary methodology, undertakings and check list for laying of Pipeline found in accordance with the latest Ministry guidelines.
- (iv) The road may be widened to 6 Lanes in future. The agency submitted the undertaking that the shifting / extending the Pipeline as and when necessary will be carried out at their own cost.
- 10. In view of the above, the Consultantshas opined that the permission may be accorded to AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd., to lay Pipeline with 2.5m depth along entire proposed stretch.
- 11. In this regard, it is to inform that the proposal submitted by AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd., is in order and in accordance with MoRT&H guidelines. The certificate in respect of conformity of the proposal is enclosed.
- 12. In view of the above, approval of the Competent Authority is sought for laying Pipeline in the utility corridor of NH in the stretch fromKm 351/000 to Km 355/500 on LHS, from km 352/100 to Km 352/500 on RHS for a length of 4900 mts & 407mm steel casing pipelilne across NH 44 at 02 nos. of locations from LHS to RHS for a length of 120 mts(total length of 5020 mts) by AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd.

SA infrastructure pvt ltd., to inspect the site and furnish comments/observations in respect of the above proposal submitted by AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd. & keeping in view of the 6 laning works and all the standard conditions issued vide Ministry / NHAI Circulars.

Upon the request of the Project Director, NHAI, PIU, Ananthapur, we conducted an inspection of the site and hereby present our observations on the proposal submitted by AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd.

Our observations are as follows:

AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd., in their referenced letter (2), proposed laying a Gas Pipeline along NH-44 from Km 351/000 to Km 355/500 on LHS, from km 352/100 to Km 352/500 on RHS

ZR. Subvanayar

&407mm steel casing pipeline across NH 44 at 02 nos. of locations from LHS to RHS for the total length of 5020 mts. The Right of Way (RoW) available is 60mtr.

- It is verified &confirming that the proposal is satisfying the MoRTH guidelines dated 22.11.2016 & 24.04.2023 applicable for NOC.
- 2. The license fee and Bank Guarantee values calculated by applicant were as per latest market rates adopted in IGRS portal.
- 3. The subjected stretch falls under the Ananthapuram urban section, where encroachment clearance must be done at the agency's expense, as per the submitted undertaking.
- 4. Methodology for crossing existing culverts and approach roads connecting to NH-44 Main Carriage Way (MCW) / Service road is stated as HDD Trenchless method, as per the submitted undertaking.
- 5. It's imperative that no NHAI property should incur damage during the work, including drains and existing utilities such as electrical and water supply pipelines.
- 6. Excavation along the entire stretch is recommended to be conducted manually.
- 7. Demarcation stones indicating NHAI offset and agency name shall be placed at every 50-meter interval.

The applicant has duly submitted undertakings and methodologies, outlining their commitment to ensuring the safety and compliance standards, including indemnification against damages, traffic management during the pipeline laying process, and prior approvals for any alterations to the gas pipeline located within the National Highway Right of Way.

Recommendations:

Upon examining the proposed trench for the steel and MDPE pipelines, it's noted that ensuring safety for road users and nearby residents is crucial. Therefore, it is advised to lay the gas pipeline at a depth exceeding 2.5 meters with encasement all around, considering potential risks associated with gas pipelines closer to the surface.

Moreover, considering the ongoing Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) duct project on the LHS of the proposed site, it's strongly recommended to lay the gas pipeline deeper than 2.5 meters for added safety to the public and road users.

Further Actions:

As the letter was addressed to M/s Arvyee associate Hyderabad for their inspection and observations, we recommend proceeding after obtaining their report on the proposal submitted by AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd.

Instructions to be Stipulated:

While granting permission, we recommend the following conditions:

- 1. Considering the existing OFC cable work, the proposal should be reviewed at a utility corridor of 0.8m beside the existing OFC cable, maintaining all safety measures.
- 2. HDD (Horizontal Directional Drilling) must be compulsorily carried out instead of open trenching in existing approach roads connecting to NH-44 within the subjected stretch.
- 3. Any encroachments should be cleared at their own risk.
- 4. Prior intimation to the Authority before start to precede the commencement of any work.
- 5. Any deviations beyond the proposal observed in the subjected stretch should warrant an immediate stoppage of work, and damages will be claimed by the authority.
- 6. Damages, if any, occurring during execution to NHAI property at the subjected stretch, should be covered by M/s. AG&P City Gas Pvt Ltd.
- 7. Our aim is to ensure safety, compliance, and seamless project maintenance.

This has reference to the letter cited, wherein it has been requested to inspect the site and furnish a detailed report on the proposal for laying Natural Gas Pipeline from Km.351+000 to 355+500 (LHS) & from Km.352+100 to 352+500on Hyderabad-Bangalore section of NH-44.

In this regard, site inspection has been carried out and following comments are herewith furnished.

- (i) Applicant M/s. AG&P has proposed to lay the 125 mm diameter MDPE pipeline & 219mm diameter steel pipeline along the highway.
- (ii) Crossings of pipelines were proposed at 2 No's locations. The diameter of encasing pipeline is of 407mm diameter.
- (iii) The following TCS has been proposed as per the Detailed Project Report.

- (iv) As per the above mentioned Typical Cross sections, provision for Utility Corridor of 2m has been made at the edge of RoW for accommodating the Utilities. The Copy of TCS is herewith Enclosed for ready reference.
- (v) The details of existing/proposed structures as per the DPR are given below:

The applicant did not mention the existing structures details in the drawings.

- (vi) In the check list at Sl.No.1.14 the offset of service road from existing service road is not mentioned.
- (vii) The stretch from Km. 352+000 to 356+000 is having thick built up area on both sides. The said stretch is having flyover structure of 350m and service roads on both sides. However, applicant is proposed the open trench method.
- (viii) We are the opinion of that open trench method is not advisable at built-up locations & flyover locations. Therefore, applicant may be directed to propose the pipeline along and across the pipeline with the HDD method only for entire length.
- (ix) Further, since the location falls in built up area, Authority is requested to direct the existing IE/OMT contractor to remove the encroachments, if any.
- (x) There is an irrigation canal crossing at Km. 351+462. However, applicant did not show the canal in the drawings and proposed to lay the pipeline along the canal. Also, there is a Major Bridge is located at Km. 354+107 and not shown in the drawings.

- (xi) Therefore, Authority is requested to direct applicant to obtain the NOC from the Irrigation department.
- (xii) M/s. NHLML under MoRT&H taking up the work of laying of Optical Fibre Telecom Infrastructure Utility Corridor on NH-44 from Km.22.000 at Hyderabad to Km.534+720 at Bangalore on LHS. Therefore, M/s.NHLML & M/s. AG&P may be instructed check their proposals in order to avoid clashes of pipelines.

In view of the above, Authority is requested to direct the applicant to comply the above observations and resubmit the proposal as per the MoRT&H Guidelines No.RW/NH-33044/29/2015/S&R (R) dt.22.11.2016 and its subsequent amendments for taking further necessary action.

This Agreement made this _____day of _____(month) of _____(year) between the Project Director, NHAI, PIU Anantapur acting in his executive capacity through National Highway Authority of India (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority" which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, include his successors in office and assigns) on the one part, and M/s AGP CITY GAS PRIVATE LIMITED, a company registered under the Companies Act, 1956 and having its Registered Office at 1st Floor, BNR Complex, Door No.8-228C, District Court Road, Anantapur-515001, Andhra Pradesh (hereinafter called the "Licensee") which expression shall unless excluded by repugnant to the context, include his successors/administrator assignees on the second part.

Whereas, the Authority is responsible, inter-alia, for development and maintenance of lands in km 351/000 to km 355/500 along & across of NH No. 44 RoW.

Whereas the Licensee proposes to lay pipeline referred to as utility services in subsequent paras.

Whereas the Licensee has applied to the Authority for permission to lay utility services from Km 351.000 to Km 355.500 on LHS, from Km 352.100 to Km 352.500 on RHS& crossings at Km 352.100 &Km 354.500 onNH-44 under NHAI in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

And whereas the Authority has agreed to grant such permission for way leave on the NH RoW as per terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned.

Now this agreement witnessed that in consideration of the conditions hereinafter contained and on the part of the Licensee to be observed and performed, the Authority hereby grants to the Licensee permission to lay utility services as per the approved drawing attached hereto subject to the following conditions, namely.

- 1. RoW permissions are only enabling in nature. The purpose of extending the way leave facility on the National Highway RoW is not for enhancing the scope of activity of a utility service provider, either by content or by intent. Further, enforceability of the permission so granted shall be restricted only to the extent of provisions/scope of activities defined in the license agreement & for the purpose for which it is granted.
- 2. No Licensee shall claim exclusive right on the RoW and any subsequent user will be permitted to use the RoW, either above or below, or by the side of the utilities laid by the first user, subject to technical requirements being fulfilled. Decision of the Authority in relation to fulfilment of technical requirements shall be final and binding on all concerned parties. In case any disruption/damage is caused to any existing user by the subsequent user, the Authority shall not be held accountable or liable in any manner.
- 3. The Licensee shall be responsible for undertaking all activities including, but not limited to site identification, survey, design, engineering, arranging finance, project management, obtaining regulatory approvals & necessary clearances, supply of equipment, material, construction, erection, testing and commissioning, maintenance and operation and all other activities essential or required for efficient functioning of their own utility/ industrial infrastructure facilities.
- 4. The Licensee shall pay license fees @ Rs_____/sqm/month to theAuthority. The License fee shall become payable from the date of handing over of RoW land to the Licensee, for laying of utilities/cables/conduits/pipelines for infrastructure/ service provider. As regards Tariff and Terms and conditions for providing common utility ducts along National Highways, there shall be a separate agreement regime.
- 5. Fee shall have to be paid in advance for the period for which permission is granted for entering into a license agreement. In case of renewal, rate prevailing at the time of renewal shall be charged. Delay in deposition of fee shall attract interest @ 15% per annum compounded annually.

- 6. Present policy of the MoRT&H is to provide a 2.00 m wide utility corridor on either side of the extreme edge of RoW. In cases where utility ducts with sufficient space are already available along NH, the utility services shall be laid in such ducts subject to technical requirements being fulfilled.
- 7. The utility services shall be laid at the edge of the RoW. In case of restricted width of RoW, which may be adequate only to accommodate the carriageway, central verge, shoulders, slopes of embankment, drains, other roadside furniture etc; the utility services shall be laid beyond the toe line of the embankments and clear of the drain.
- 8. The Licensee shall make his own arrangement for crossing of cross drainage structure, rivers, etc. below the bed. In case, this is not feasible, the utility services may be carried outside the railings/parapets and the bridge superstructure. The fixing and supporting arrangement with all details shall be required to be approved in advance from the concerned Highway Administration. Additional cost on account of fixing and supporting arrangement as assessed by the Authority shall be payable by the Licensee.
- 9. In exceptional cases, where RoW is restricted the utility services can be allowed beneath the carriageway of service road, if available, subject to the condition that the utility services be laid in concrete ducts, which will be designed to carry traffic on top. The width of the duct shall not be less than one lane. In such cases, it also needs to ensure that maintenance of the utility services shall not interfere with the safe and smooth flow of traffic. The cost of operation and maintenance will have to be borne by the Licensee.
- 10. It is to be ensured that at no time there is interference with the drainage of the road land and maintenance of the National Highways. Towards this, the top of the utility services shall be at least 0.6 metre below the ground level. However, any structure above ground shall be aesthetically provided for / landscaped with required safety measures as directed by the concerned Authority;
- 11. The utility services shall be permitted to cross the National Highway either through structure or conduits specially built for that purpose. The casing / conduit pipe should, as minimum, extend from drain to drain in cuts and toe of slope to toe of slope in the fills and shall be designed in accordance with the provision of IRC and executed following the Specifications of the Ministry.
- 12. Existing drainage structures shall not be allowed to carry the lines across.
- 13. The top of the casing/conduit pipe containing the utility services to cross the road shall be at least 1.2m below the top of the sub grade or the existing ground level whichever is lower, subject to being at lease 0.3m below the drain inverts. A typical sketch showing the clearances is given in Attachment-I.
- The utility services shall cross the National Highway preferable on a line normal to it or as nearly so as practicable.

- 15. The casing/conduit pipe for crossing the road may be installed under the road embankment either by boring or digging a trench. Installation by boring method shall be preferred.
- 16. In case of trenching, the sides of the trench should be done as nearly vertical as possible. The trench width should be at least 30 cm. but not more than 60 cms wider than the outer diameter of the pipe. Filling of the trench shall conform to the specifications contained here-in-below or as supplied by the Highway Authority.
 - a. Bedding shall be to a depth not less than 30 cm. It shall consist of granular material, free of lumps, clods and cobbles, and graded to yield a firm surface without sudden change in the bearing value. Unsuitable soil and rock edges should be excavated and replaced by selected material.
 - b. The backfill shall be completed in two stages (i) Side-fill to the level of the top of the pipe (ii) Overfill to the bottom of the road crust.
 - c. The side fill shall consist of granular material laid in 15 cm. Layers each consolidated by mechanical tamping and controlled addition of moisture to 95% of the Proctor's Density. Overfill shall be compacted to the same density as the material that had been removed. Consolidation by saturation or ponding will not be permitted.
 - d. The road crust shall be built to the same strength as the existing crust on either side of the trench or to thickness and specifications stipulated by the Highway Authority.
- 17. The Licensee shall ensure making good the excavated trench for laying utility services by proper filling and compaction, so as to restore the land into the same condition as it was before digging the trench, clearing debris/loose earth produced due to execution of trenching at least 50m away from the edge of the right of way;
- 18. All required restoration works subsequent to laying of the cable shall be required to be undertaken by the Licensee at its cost either by itself or through its authorized representative in consultation with the Authority as per predetermined time schedule and quality standards.
- 19. Prior to commencement of any work on the ground, a performance Bank Guarantee @ Rs. 250 per route metre with a validity of one yearinitially (extendable if required till satisfactory completion of work) shall have to be furnished by the Licensee to the Authority/its designated agency as a security against improper restoration of ground in terms of filling/unsatisfactory compaction damages caused to other underground installations/utility services & interference, interruption, disruption or failure caused thereof to any services etc.In case of the Licensee failing to discharge the obligation of making good of the excavated trench/other restoration work, the Authority shall have a right to make good the damages caused by excavation, at the cost of the Licensee and recover the amount by forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee.

- 20. In case, the Performance Bank Guarantee is invoked as mentioned above, the Licensee shall be required to replenish and reinstate the required Performance Bank Guarantee within one month of such invoking. In case the work contemplated herein is not completed to the satisfaction of the Authority, which has granted the permission, within a period of 11 months from the date of issue of the Bank Guarantee, the Licensee shall either furnish a fresh guarantee or extend the guarantee for a further period of one year. Notwithstanding this, the Licensee shall be liable to pay full compensation to the aggrieved Authority/ its designated agency for any damage sustained by them by reason of the exercise of the RoWfacility;
- 21. The Licensee shall shift the utility services within 90 days (or as specified by the respective Authority from the date of issue of the notice by the concerned Authority to shift/relocate the utility services, in case it is so required for the purpose of improvement/widening of the road/route/highway or construction of flyover/bridge and restore the road/land to its original condition at his own cost and risk.
- 22. The Licensee shall be responsible to ascertain from the respective agency in coordination with Authority, regarding the location of other utilities /underground installations/ facilities etc. The Licensee shall ensure the safety and security of already existing underground installations/utilities/facilities etc. before commencement of the excavation/using the existing cable ducts. The Licensee shall procure insurance from a reputed insurance company against damages to already existing underground installations/utilities/facilities etc.
- 23. TheLicensee shall be solely responsible/ liablefor fullcompensation/indemnification of concerned agency / aggrieved Authority for any direct, indirect or consequential damage caused to them/claims or replacements sought for, at the cost and risk of the Licensee. The concerned agency in coordination with Authority shall also have a right make good such damages/ recover the claims by forfeiture of Bank Guarantee.
- 24. If the Licensee fails to comply with any condition to the satisfaction of the Authority, the same shall be executed by the Authority at the cost and risk of the Licensee.
- 25. Grant of License is subject to the Licensee satisfying (a) minimum disruption of traffic and (b) no damage to the highways. As far as possible, the Licensee should avoid cutting of the road for crossing highway, and other roads and try to carry out the work by trenchless technology. In case any damage is caused to the road pavement in this process, the Licensee will be required to restore the road to the original condition at its cost. If due to unavoidable reasons the road needs to be cut for crossing or laying utility services, the Licensee has to execute the restoration work in a time bound manner at its cost either by itself or through its authorized representative in consultation with the Authority as per predetermined time schedule and quality standards. In case of the Licensee failing to discharge the obligation of making good of the excavated trench/other restoration work, the Authority shall have a right to make good the damages caused by excavation, at the cost of the Licensee and recover the amount by forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee.

- 26. The Licensee shall inform/give a notice to the concerned agency designated by the Authority at least 15 day in advance with route details prior to digging trenches, for fresh or maintenance/repair works. A separate performance Bank Guarantee for maintenance/repair works shall have to be furnished by the Licensee.
- 27. Each day, the extent of digging the trenches should be strictly regulated so that utility services is laid and trenches filled up before the close of the work that day. Filling should be completed to the satisfaction of the concerned agency designated by the Authority.
- 28. The licensee shall indemnify the concerned agency in co-ordination with Authority, against all damages and claims, if any due to the digging of trenches for laying cables/ducts.
- 29. The permission for laying utility services is granted maximum for 5 years at a time, which can thereafter be considered for renewal. On payment of additional fee at the time of renewal, the permission shall automatically be renewed, unless defaults exist. In case of renewal, rate prevailing at the time of renewal shall be charged. Delay in deposition of fee shall attract interest @ 15% per annum compounded annually.
- 30. The permission shall be valid only for the period it is issued, and fee deposited. However, the Authority also has a right to terminate the permission or to extend the period of Agreement.
- 31. That the Licensee shall not undertake any work of shifting, repairs or alterations to the utility services without prior written permission of the concerned agency in coordination with the Authority.
- 32. The permission granted shall not in any way be deemed to convey to the Licensee any ownership right or any interest in route/road/highway land /property, other than what is herein expressly granted. No use of NH RoW will be permitted for any purpose other than that specified in the Agreement.
- 33. During the subsistence of this Agreement, the utility services located in highway land / property shall be deemed to have been constructed and continued only by the consent and permission of the Authority so that the right of the Licensee to the use thereof shall not become absolute and indefeasible by lapse of time.
- 34. The Licensee shall bear the Stamp Duty charged on this Agreement.
- 35. Three copies of 'as laid drawings' of utilities (hard and soft copies) with geotagged photographs and geo-tagged video recordings of laying of pipelinesin the trench (with respect to the NH) and after complete restoration shall be submitted to the Authority for verification and record within a month of completion of works.
- 36. The Licensee shall allow free access to the Site at all times to the authorised representatives of Authority to inspect the Project Facilities and to investigate anymatter within their Authority, and upon reasonable notice, shall provide reasonable assistance necessary to carry out their respective duties and functions.

- 37. The utility services shall not be made operational by the Licensee unless a completion certificate to the effect that the utility services has been laid in accordance with the approved specifications and drawings and the trenches have been filled up to the satisfaction of the concerned agency in co-ordination with the Authority has been obtained. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, this Agreement may be cancelled at any time by Authority for breach of any condition of the same and the Licensee shall neither be entitled to any compensation for any loss caused to it by such cancellation not shall it be absolved from any liability already incurred.
- 38. The Licensee shall ensure adherence to relevant Indian standards and follow best industry practices, methods and standards for the purpose of ensuring the safe, efficient and economic design, construction, commissioning, operation, repair and maintenance of any part of the utility lines/industrial infrastructure facilities and which practices, methods and standards shall be adjusted as necessary, to take account of:
 - a. operation, repair and maintenance guidelines given by the manufacturers,
 - b. the requirements of Law,
 - c. the physical conditions at the Site, and
 - d. The safety of operating personnel and human beings.
 - 39. The Licensee shall have to provide safety measures like barricading, danger lighting and other necessary caution boards while executing the work.
 - 40. While laying utility services, at least one lane of road shall be kept open to traffic at all times. In case of single lane roads, a diversion shall be constructed. If any traffic diversion works are found necessary during the working period such diversion shall be provided at the cost of Licensee.
 - 41. After the termination/expiry of the agreement, the Licensee shall remove the utility services within 90 days and the site shall be brought back to the original condition failing which the Licensee will lose the right to remove the utility services. However before taking up the work of removal of utility services the Licensee shall furnish a Bank Guarantee to the Authority for a period of one year for an amount assessed by the Authority as a security for making good the excavated trench by proper filling and compaction, clearing debris, loose earth produced due to excavation of trenching at least 50m away from the edge of the RoW
 - 42. Any disputes in interpretation of the terms and conditions of this Agreement or their implementation shall be referred to the redress mechanism prevailing in the Ministry and the decision of the redress mechanism shall be final and binding on all.
 - 43. For PPP Projects, in case of any financial loss incurred by the respective project concessionaires due to such laying/shifting of utility services by the Licensee, compensation for the same shall be required to be borne by the Licensee in mutual agreement with the respective project concessionaires. MoRT&H/ NHAI/

implementing authorities for the project shall not be liable to the concessionaire in any way in this regard.

Methodology adopted for laying of pipeline

- 1. After thorough study of entire stretch of proposed pipeline laying, we have proposed to laying of 125mm dia. MDPE & 219mm Dia Steel pipeline along NH-44 from Km 351.000 to Km 355.500 on LHS, from Km 352.100 to Km 352.500 on RHS (Thapovanam to Rudrampeta) for a length of 4900 mts& 407mm Dia Steel casing pipeline across NH-44 at Km 352.100, Km 354.500 for a length of 120 mts and for a total length of 5020 mtsalong Hyderabad-Bangalore section of NH-44 as a part of Providing Gas Supply in Anantapur District of AP, under the limits of NHAI.
- 2. We have proposed to lay our pipeline at 1.0 m from the extreme boundary according to the availability of space.

Protection technology in case of culverts /canals

1. Pipeline invert level will be kept above the water level in the drains or culverts by constructing abutments and thrust blocks at the ends and middle if necessary. However the same shall be discussed with the NHAI officials on case to case basis and pipe routing shall be decided as per their advice.

Methods

- 1. Open trench include Manual and Machine trenching
- 2. Trenchless technology by Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) Method
- 3. Bridge Crossing Open trench method:

Open trench method:

There will be a continuous digging following a single line in an open trench. The depth of the trench will be 2.5 m in the normal soil condition. Open trench will be carried out manually and with machines. Cross section of the trench is attached herewith. Trench will be in ROW limits and will be marked with lime powder to keep it straight. Trench will be barricaded with safety signs. This method will be used wherever normal soil is available for open trench. Trench will be laid clear of drains, service roads, truck lay bays wherever existing on the Highways. In case of Hilly terrain pipeline laying will be done by breaking the hard rock with means of Pneumatic breaker by following safety measures and the excavated trench will be backfilled with borrowed soil.

Backfilling: Backfilling shall be done with well compacted Granular material after ensuring soft material padding. Adequate dry compaction shall be done before crowning. Compaction shall be done in layers of 15 cm each. The trench shall be filled up to the required height of

2.5 m measured from top of pipe trench cross section drawing attached in the proposal. A crown of 250mm shall be made at top of backfilled trench to cater for soil settlement. No surplus soil shall be left outside the trench. Entire area shall be restored and debris removed and disposed off in a safe manner and in line with requirements of the authority having jurisdiction over the area.

Methodology adopted for laying of pipeline

Installation of pipeline in crossings by Trenchless Techniques (HDD)

For the process of HDD excavation of only 2 pits each of standard size 3x0.8x1.65 is required which is called entry pit and exit pit on outside ROW. Pit size may vary based on site condition. The first stage drills a pilot hole on the designed path, and the second stage (reaming) enlarges the hole by passing a larger cutting tool known as reamer. The reamer's diameter depends on the size of the duct to be pulled back through the bore hole. The driller increases the diameter according to the outer diameter or the conduit and to achieve optimal production. The third stage places the duct in the enlarged hole by the way of the drill stern. It is pulled behind the reamer to allow cantering of the duct in the newly renamed path. Pit site may vary based on site condition. Entry and exit pits shall be dug at both ends of the segment which shall later on become either a location for manhole/hand-hole. The drilled hole profile between entry and exit pits (except transition areas) shall be as straight as possible.

Water Body Crossing

water bodies and other natural obstructions can be crossed by open-cut method without using existing infrastructures such as bridges and culverts depending upon the availability of permissions from concerned authorities. In the cases, pipe line laying technique shall be such that protection of DI Pipe line is ensured. Necessary protection will be provided.

crossings cross roads, Approach Road, Acceleration & Deceleration Lanes and Fuel station Roads No trenching will be done on the link road, boring methods will be used for crossing the cross road, Approach roads, Acceleration & Deceleration lanes and Fuel station roads. Pipeline will be laid at the extreme edge of the road in the non-BT surface only.

Crossing of a small river or channel by HDD

Open cut method is used when installation on bridge / culvert is not available. This method however is more suited to seasonal water bodies (prone to flowing water such as nala/ stream / river/ canal etc.) which may be completely /partially dry during installation period.

This method can also be used for small water bodies where it is possible divert water for short period of installation.

Note: Trench Technology will be used (e.g.: HDD) where ever available ROW is restricted and utility corridors cannot be conveniently earmarked.

- In case of any major alterations/deviations to the existing vagu coarse during laying of said pipe line is necessitated, the concerned designs and drawings are to be submitted to the concerned Executive Engineer of Water Resources Department for obtaining approval from the competent authority.
- 3. The proposed pipe line laying work should not obstruct the flow of water through Nadimi vanka and cause inconvenience to field staff attending to their regular duties and inspection by Water Resources Department Officials.

(P.T.O)

4. The pipe line laying will be allowed only during Non flow days/very meagre flow in the Nadimi vanka/Vagu.

5. Any loss or damages occurred to Water Resources Department property such as vanka banks, inspection path, dowel banks etc., during laying of pipe line at work site has to be rectified by the AG & P Private Limited at their own cost.

 Cooperation of AG & P Private Limited agency should be extended to the Water Resources Department authorities while executing any department related works on Nadimi vanka by field staff in future.

7. AG & P agency should follow the instructions of the field officers of Water Resources Dept., authorities while laying the pipe at Nadimi vanka site.

8. Upon laying of the pipe line, the banks of Nadimi vanka should be backfilled and handed over to the authority.

9. For ensuring safety valve stations are to be installed away from the banks of Nadimi vanka along the pipe line.

10. The AG & P Private Limited, Ananthapuramu will be held responsible for any untoward incidents and any loss of lives etc.,

11. Garbage/Sewage should not be dumped into the vanka/vagu.

12. The permission does not attract any legal claims.

13. It should not be concluded that, the permission will confirm any right title or ownership of government lands in the vicinity of the Water Resources Department lands.

14. After grant of permission of the proposals, the agency should intimate to the concerned field level officers before starting of work and upon completion of work.

15. The permission stands cancelled automatically when above conditions are violated.




