taluk, Bijapur District, Karnataka State-Reg.

The Project Director, NHAI, PIU, Solapur vide letter No. NHAI/PIU/SLP/SB/Retail Outlet/15026/2018-19/1/4651 dated 03.09.2019 (Annexure I) has submitted the above proposal to this office. The Project Director, NHAI, PIU, Solapur vide letter cited above, has stated that, the mud road shown in the earlier submitted drawing in Sy. No. 67/2 at a distance of 147m towards Vijayapura is not a government road and is not included in any road network of PMGSY or CMGSY of the district / block. Also it is not included in Road Development plan 2001-2021 for the district and the same is certified by AEE, PWD, Indi division vide letter dated 29.07.2019. Further, PD, NHAI, PIU, Solapur has reported that, the said mud road at a distance of 147 m is an unauthorized mud road serving to 2 farm houses located on agriculture land. One is a hut and the other is farm-house belonging to the LOI holder of the proposed retail outlet. Also, this road is not in the CA agreement for four laning of Solapur - Vijayapur road for Junction development, this clearly shows that this is unauthorized access and hence is not considered for criteria of intersection with rural road. Further, village road at 1200m is to be considered for intersection with rural road. Accordingly, the proposal is re-submitted without showing the mud road in the proposal. The drawings are enclosed as Annexure II. Justification is enclosed as Annexure IV.

- As per Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH/33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016 (Annexure III), the Highway Administrator will make available the relaxation proposal of Oil company for public comments, and the comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading.
- In view of the above, the comments from public on the above mentioned proposal is invited on public portal for access permission to fuel station on website of Ministry and Road Transport and Highways (www.morth.nic.in) and to the following address as per Form-A (copy enclosed).

With reference to above cited subject M/s Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd vide letter under Reference No 3, has submitted amended proposal, for Issue of Access permission for installation of new MS/HSD retail outlet abutting on the Left Side Solapur-Bijapur Section road NH-13 (New NH-52) at Km57+890 (design Ch 66+484) in survey No 67/2of the village Kapinimbargi, Taluka-Indi Dist. Vijaypura in the Karnataka state.

A. This office has forwarded the proposal to the Independent Engineer M/s DCSPL to verify and submit their comments vide this office letter under reference no -2 dated 26.07.2019.

Accordingly the Independent Engineer has submitted their report vide letter under reference No 1 dated 27.07.2019. and their comments are as below.

The location of proposed retailed outlet is from Ch. 66 + 457 To 66+512 on LHS of Solapur Vijayapur project highway.

The comments of IE regarding the said proposal have already been submitted vide

is not suitable. In this regard IE has to submitted their comments and recommendation which are as below.

- i. The mud road shown in the drawing is not included in any road network of PMGSY or CMGSY of the district/block. Also it is not included in Road Development Plan 2001-2021 for the district.
- ii. The mud road mentioned in the drawing submitted in earlier proposal is unauthorized road serving to 2 farm houses located on agriculture land. One is a hut and the other is farm-house belonging to the LOI holder of the proposed outlet.
- iii. As such, this unauthorized road was not considered as rural road/approach road to private and public properties by IE while submitting the comments on earlier proposal. Hence, IE sticks up to the comments submitted vide Ref-6 only.
- iv. IE had mentioned the distance of VR as 1200 M towards Vijayapur side, which is more than 300 M vide Ref-6 and hence recommended for granting access permission to the retailed outlet.
- C. Also this road is not in the CA agreement for Four laning of Solapur Vijayapur road for Junction development, this clearly shows that this is unauthorized access. However, if required the said proposal may be approved with relaxation.
- D. As per the MoRT&H guidelines RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO-III dated 24.07.2013 the nonrefundable processing fee of Rs 10,000/- is paid through bharatkosh.gov.in payable at Bangalore. (The copy of receipt is attached)

In view of above this office concurs with the comments of Independent Engineer and hereby recommends for issue of NOC for NH access permission to retail outlet by M/s HPCL abutting on LHS of NH-52 (old NH-13) Solapur- Vijayapura Road Section at Km 66+484 in survey no 67/2 of Kapanimbargi village, Balloli Hobli, in taluka Indi, Dist. Vijayapura in the state of Karnataka as per the earlier proposal submitted vide letter under ref-5. as per Ministry's policy guidelines from the Competent Authority Thanking You

Sub: Guidelines/norms for access permission to Fuel Stations, Private Properties, Rest Area Complexes and such other facilities along National Highways- reg.

The power to give for access to National Highways lies with the Highway Administration as per the Highway Administration Rule, 2004 under the control of National Highways (Land and Traffic) Act, 2002. While exercising this power, the Ministry issued the general guidelines/norms for access permission to fuel stations, private properties, rest area complexes and other facilities vide Ministry's Circular No. RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO-III dated 24.7.2013. The norms and guidelines were issued as per enclosures of the Circular at Appendix-1 (along with Annex-I. II & III to Appendix-1) and Appendix-II (along with Annex-I. II and III to Appendix-II).

- 2. The Ministry has been receiving many cases of relaxation from the Ministry's norms stipulated in the Circular under reference. It has been observed that many cases of deviations from the extant guidelines, specifically distance from intersection, gap in central median, distance from nearest fuel station, distance from toll plaza and non-fulfillment of the criteria of construction within a year of issuing NOC have been received for relaxation by the Ministry. Further, many complaints and RTI applications against relaxation have also been received in the Ministry.
- 3. In view of the above, it has been decided that the application for relaxation in the guidelines/norms for access permission to fuel stations, private properties, rest area complexes and other such facilities along National Highway will be filled up by the applicants through online forms and will be submitted to the concerned Highway Administrator. Before the issue of provisional NOC and in principle approval, the Highway Administrator will make available in the Ministry's website (morth.nic.in) the complete application for public comments, thereby bringing out the relaxation sought by the applicant. Comments will be invited within 60 days

from day of uploading and will be in the format as enclosed as Form-A. The Highway Administrator will subsequently take the decision on the application in a speaking order for accepting or rejecting the relaxation sought and taking into consideration the objections received on the matter. The applicant may have a further period of 30 days for appealing against the Highway Administrator to the Appellate Authority who will be the Chief Engineer of the respective Project Zone in Ministry of Road Transport & Highways. Chief Engineers will take into consideration the application of the applicant seeking relaxation, the objections received from the general public and the speaking order of Highway Administrator to decide on the appeal. The order of the Appellate Authority shall be final.

- The Highway Administrator will issue the 'in principle' approval and the Provisional NOC for the applications, where relaxation of norms has been sought, only after the completion of the process illustrated in the preceding paragraph.
- 5. This circular will be read in continuation with circular of Ministry dated24.7.2013 mentioned in first paragraph. The other provisions of the earlier circular will remain applicable.
- 6. The competent authority in the Ministry shall notify the Appellate Authorities for their respective Highways Administration. The centents of this Circular may be brought to the notice of all the concerned in your organization.
- 7. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
