3. The oil company inform about there was delay in transferring the land to Oil Company due to some legal permission. It resulted in delay of construction work of retail outlet. Copy of land transferring letter is enclosed for ready reference. Thus M/s HPCL could not start the work immediately on the site in absence of these statutory approvals as budget is approved only when all the statutory approvals are in hand. Since the site required deep filling and there was difficulty in getting filling material.
4. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No. RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO-III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
5. Keeping in view the ground cited above, The oil company has requested to kindly accord approval for extension of provisional NOC period under relaxation so that the oil company complete the construction work as per approved drawing and obtain completion certificate for final formal permission including signing of license deed and the same that they can energize the aforesaid retail outlet.

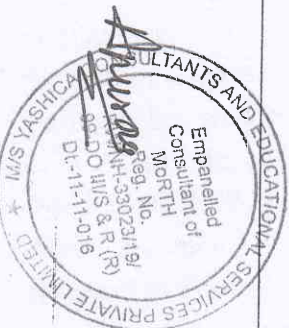
