The proposal is regarding permission for laying of Optical Fibre cable on NH-7 from Km 89.300 to Km 90.300 (LHS) and Km 89.580 to Km 90.300 (RHS) and crossing at Km 90.300 on Hosur - Krishnagiri section of NH-44 (Old NH-7) submitted to this office by the PD, NHAI, Krishnagiri vide letter No. NHAI/11013/OFC/2019/PIU-K'giri/1929 dt.29.11.2019 (Received on 02.12.2019)

2. The alignment proposed by M/s. Bharti Airtel Ltd, Chennai on NH-7 (Hosur - Krishnagiri section) in the State of Tamil Nadu as detailed under:

3. M/s. Bharti Airtel Limited, Chennai has proposed to lay 20mm dia OFC Cable and the top of the proposed casing pipe at a depth of 1.65 from the ground level with 40mm dia (PLB) encasing pipes along the road and 150mm RCC casing pipes across the road.

4. M/s. Bharti Airtel Limited, Chennai has furnished an undertaking to accept any claims raised by the Concessionaire if any and the same will be paid by them. An undertaking not to damage other utility, if damaged, then to pay the losses either to NHAI or to the concerned agency. Further, the applicant has undertaken to relocate cable lines/utilities at their own cost, notwithstanding the permission granted within such time as will be stipulated by NHAI for future development.

5. As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No. RW/NH-33044/29/2015/ S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016, the proposal submitted by M/s. Bharti Airtel Ltd, Chennai will be made available for public comments/objections and the comments will be invited within 30 days from the day of uploading.
