Sub.: NOC for access permission to the proposed fuel station of M/s Essar Oil Limited at Km. 74.572 (Ch. 74.582, LHS) on NH-233 (New NH No. 28), Village-Vishunpur, Tehsil-Bhanpur & District-Basti in the State of Uttar Pradesh – Reg.

1. The Project Director, MoRT&H, PIU, Basti vide letter no. PIU/Basti/NH-233/2/NOC/2015-16/135 dated 28.03.2018 has submitted a proposal for access permission in respect of fuel station mentioned in the subject above.

2. From the drawings submitted with the proposal, it is seen that there are two no. Earthen/pedestrian tracks at a distance of 181m & another 190m opposite along canal towards Basti side from the proposed fuel station site which terminates at field. There is another kharajna road having total length of 45m, and width less than 3m, at a distance of 220m towards Bansi side from the proposed fuel station, which goes to few houses and terminates at fields. As per Ministry's guidelines dated 24.07.2013, para 4.5.1 (ii), no intersection with rural roads/approach roads to private & public properties should exist within 300m. on either side of proposed fuel station.

2.1 The Oil Company has requested for relaxation in view of para 2 above. The reasons for relaxation as recommended by Project Director, PIU, MoRT&H, are as follows:

(i) Applicant has proposed to construct either side of site 5.50m wide and 813m long service road including deceleration lane, acceleration lane with separator covering intersections at applicant own cost.

(ii) There are two Earthen/pedestrian tracks at a distance of 181m & another 190m opposite along canal towards Basti side from the proposed fuel station site which terminates at fields. There is below 3m wide Kharanja road having total length of 45m at a distance of 220m towards Bansi side from the proposed fuel station goes to few houses and terminate at field.

(iii) Only pedestrians & cyclists use these road and no vehicles ply on these tracks/road.

(iv) Construction of retail outlet not only involves infrastructure development through MOP&NG, in the area but also provides bread and butter to several families.

(v) Essar Oil Limited proposed retail outlet will generate healthy competition & thus will benefit the NH road users & villagers in terms of quantity & quality of product.

3. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
