Invitation of public comments

Sub.: Proposal for final formal permission and signing of license deed for access to the proposed fuel station of M/s IOCL at Km.19.00 old (Ch.18.948 LHS), new Km. 38.00 (ch.37.648, LHS) on NH-11 at Khasra no. 162/9, Vill.- Rasoolpur, Tehsil- Kiraoli, Distt - Agra in the State of Uttar Pradesh - Time extension - Reg.

1. The provisional NOC for the instant retail outlet was granted by this office letter no. RO/LKO/HA/NH-11/109/14/3073 dated 18.08.2015 with the condition that "in case the construction is not done in one year of the issue of this provisional NOC, the same shall be deemed to be cancelled, unless renewed by the Competent Authority". However, it is seen that the case has been submitted after the elapse of said deadline. In this regard, Regional Officer (CGM), UP-West, NHAI, Lucknow vide letter dated 06.07.2018 has submitted justification for the delay in construction of the instant retail outlet, enclosing therewith format for relaxation in light of the deviation from the extant guidelines.

2. The Oil Company M/s IOCL has sought relaxation for the above mentioned deviation on the following ground:

(i) NOC from District Magistrate was granted to M/s IOCL on 10.04.2017, i.e. around one year and eight months after the provisional NOC was issued. It resulted in delay of construction work for the retail outlet. M/s IOCL could not start the work immediately on site in absence of these statutory approval as budget is approved only when all the statutory approvals are in hand.

3. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
