The Authorised Signatory, Lightstorm Telecom Connectivity Pvt. Ltd. has submitted the proposal for permission of laying U/G Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along NH-09 (Hapur-Gajraula Section) from Ch. 77.180 to Ch. 78.220 (RHS), CH. 92.480 to Ch. 95.313 (LHS & RHS), 02 Nos crossing 60m each at Ch. 92.480 & Ch. 95.313 (Total length 6826m) including 782m clamping (LHS & RHS) from Ch. 93.175 to Ch. 93.957 (Total Length of clamping 1564m) in District-Hapur in the State of Uttar Pradesh.

2. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33044/29/2015/ S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016, the application shall be put out in the public domain for 30 days for seeking claims and objections (on grounds of public inconvenience, safety and general public interest). In this regard, RO-UP(West), NHAI, Lucknow vide letter no. 19001/1/RO-W-UP/Utility/19471 dated 21.03.2023 has also issued directions to put out the application of Public and Industrial Utility Services along and across National Highway in the public domain for 30-days for seeking public comments at PIU Level.
