- 2. The Right of Way in the stretch of NH proposed for laying water pipe line is from 26.80 to 31.20m. The carriageway width of stretch across at Km 4/220,Km 10/925,Km 16/143,Km 20/137 & Km 20/551 of NH-381 is from 14.00 to 16.00m. The Commissioner, Tiruppur City municipal Corporation, Tiruppur has proposed to lay the underground water pipeline Public Utility at Km 4/220,Km 10/925,Km 16/143,Km 20/137 & Km 20/551 for a length of 19m by adopting HDD method across the National Highway.
- 3. The Commissioner, Tiruppur City municipal Corporation, Tiruppur has furnished an undertaking to the effect that they will remove the laid Public Utility water pipe line in future if required by NH wing of State Highways Department, Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India at any time for expansion of the NH at their own cost without claiming any compensation from NH wing of Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India and any right on the NH land. Further, mentioned that, the Commissioner, Tiruppur City municipal Corporation, Tiruppur will also restore the ROW surfaces to its original condition soon after removal of the Public utility water pipe lines. Also, certified that the proposed Public Utility work will not affect the design, stability, traffic safety and future improvement of the proposed stretch.
