Subject:- Permission proposal for laying underground 200mm dia GI treated waste water pipe line along the extreme end of National Highways boundary from Km 156/300 to 157/636(RHS) and crossing at Km 156/300 of NH-544 in the state of Tamil Nadu-Regarding.

The proposal is regarding request for permission for laying underground 200mm dia GI treated waste water pipe line along the extreme end of National Highways boundary from Km 156/300 to 157/636(RHS) and crossing at Km 156/300 of NH-544 in the state of Tamil Nadu by M/s Sharadha Terry Products Private Limited, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore submitted to this office by the SE (NH), Salem vide letter No.2902/2021/JDO/NH/ dated 29.11.2021(received on 23.12.2021). The proposal has been examined and the details are as under:

2. The Right of Way in the stretch of NH proposed for laying waste water pipe line is 45.00m. The carriageway width of stretch from Km 156/300 to 157/636(RHS) of NH-544 is 7.00m. M/s Sharadha Terry Products Private Limited, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore has proposed to lay the underground Public Utility at edge of the ROW for a length of 1336m by adopting open trench method along the National Highway and HDD method across at Km 156/300 the National Highway.

3. M/s Sharadha Terry Products Private Limited, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore has furnished an undertaking to the effect that they will remove the laid Public Utility waste water pipe line in future if required by NH wing of State Highways Department, Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India at any time for expansion of the NH at their own cost without claiming any compensation from NH wing of Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India and any right on the NH land. Further, mentioned that, M/s Sharadha Terry Products Private Limited, Mettupalayam, Coimbatore will also restore the ROW surfaces to its original condition soon after removal of the Public utility waste water pipe lines. Also, certified that the proposed Public Utility work will not affect the design, stability, traffic safety and future improvement of the proposed stretch.

4. As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No.RW/NH-33044/29/2015/S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016 the application will be made available for public comments and the comments will be invited within 30 days from the day of uploading the same in the web site of Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for public comments.
