Invitation of public comments

Sub.: Proposal for provisional NOC for access permission to the proposed retail outlet of M/s Indian Oil Corporation Limited in Km.59 (Ch. 58.793, RHS) on NH-96 (New NH-330) at Village - Karista, Tehsil - Patti & District - Pratapgarh in the State of Uttar Pradesh -Reg.

The Chief Engineer (NH), UP PWD, Lucknow, vide letter no. 1179NH/92N/18 dated 07.05.2019 has submitted a proposal for issue of provisional NOC for access road permission to the proposed fuel station mentioned in subject.

- From the submitted location plan, it is noted that there is a 2.5m wide kharanja road at a distance of 120m and another 3.0m wide painted road at a distance of 220m on opposite side from the proposed retail outlet. Thus, the proposal in its present form does not conform to Ministry's guidelines dated 24.07.2013, Clause 4.5.1.1(ii), wherein it is stipulated that the minimum distance of intersection with rural roads from the retail outlet shall be 300m.
- The Oil Company has requested for relaxation in view of para 2 above. The reasons for relaxation as recommended by the Chief Engineer (NH), UP PWD, Lucknow are as follows:
- There is 2.5m wide kharanja road at a distance of 120m from site, which terminates at field and another 3.0m wide painted road at a distance of 220m from the site which terminates at houses. Due to this, heavy traffic does not playing on these roads. Only cyclists and pedestrians use these accesses.
- Applicant has connected existing intersection which is situated at the distance of 450m towards Pratapgarh side and 320m towards Faizabad side through proposed 5.5m wide and 981m long service road starting at Ch.58.270 to Ch.59.251, including A/D lanes with separator, so approach of proposed site will from service road. Hence, approach of proposed site will not hinder to NH traffic or not affect road safety.
- Construction of retail outlet not only involves infrastructure development through MOPN&G in the area but also provides bread and butter to several families.
- As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
- In view of the above, comments of the public on the above relaxation proposal is invited 4. to the below mentioned address:
