**Sub: First cum first serve order for funds for incurring expenditure on the implementation of works sanctioned under LWE Scheme during the financial year 2024-25-reg.**

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's sanction letter of even number dated 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2024, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to revise overall allocation to **Rs.150 Crore (Rupees One Hundred And Fifty Crore only)** for incurring expenditure towards works sanctioned under LWE- TSP head for the Financial Year 2024-25 for the States of Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Odisha.

2. Office of Pr. CCA may allow concerned ROs/RPAOs to admit expenditure for LWE-TSP works on purely first come first served basis henceforth during 2024-25 out of the total outlay of Rs.150 Crore subject to the condition that office of Principal CCA shall ensure that overall expenditure for scheme/head being executed through State PWDs is not exceeded at any point of time under the head, as these would ensure that bills pertaining to well performing States are cleared without any delay and there is no gestation period involved on account of the requirement to enhance their outlay at any stage in case the above States allocation is fully exhausted, as long as the total outlay of Rs.150 Crore funded for LWE-TSP works for these States is not fully exhausted.

3. The expenditure is debitable to the head under Demand No. 86 - Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2024-25 as given below:-



4. The works under LWE-TSP scheme are to be implemented on the pattern of National Highway Works and Direct Payment Procedure as being adopted for NH works.

5. While entertaining the claims on the basis of allocation referred to above, it may please be ensure that:-

- 1) Expenditure is incurred only on sanctioned works (NHs and State Roads) in LWE affected area only.
  - 2) No claim is entertained for expenditure incurred on any sanctioned works in excess of the sanctioned cost beyond permissible limits.
  - 3) No expenditure is admitted on work/portion of the work where it might have been specifically advised not to incur any expenditure pending receipt/approval of certain issues/points, etc.
6. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Wing vide their Note No.#36 dated 19.3.2025.


