Out of total BE allocation of ₹ 4,500.00 crore under SARDP-NE for the financial year 2023-24, an amount of ₹ 1,412.00 crore has been allocated to States/UTs and ₹ 1,000.00 crore has been released to NHIDCL. After release of this sanction letter of ₹500.00 crore, an amount of ₹ 1,588.00 crore is reserve/balance in the head of account SARDP-NE.
