In continuation of this Ministry's sanction letter of even number dated 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2024, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to allocate and release funds under National Highways (Original)-NE [NH(O)-NE] Scheme to National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) for NH works entrusted to NHAI during the Financial Year 2023-24 as per details given below:

2. The above expenditure is debitible to the following head under Demand No.86 - Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2023-24:-

5054 -Capital Outlay on Road & Bridges (Major Head)  
01 -National Highway (Sub - Major Head)  
01.337 -Road Works (Minor Head)  
05 -Special Accelerated Road Development Programme in North Eastern Areas financed from National Investment Fund  
05.03 -Works under Road Wing/State PWDs  
05.03.73 -Infrastructural Assets ”.

3. There is total BE provision of ₹ 6,057.00 crore under NH(O)-NE (from NIF) for the financial year 2023-24. Out of which ₹ 4,000.00 crore has been allocated/released to NHIDCL and 700.00 crore has been released to NHAI. After release of this amount of ₹1,357.00 crore (Total: ₹2,057.00 crore) to NHAI, Nil amount is reserve/balance in the head of account”.

4. It shall be ensured that the expenditure against above sanction is incurred only on the NH works entrusted to NHAI by the Ministry.

5. The accounts of National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the C&AG and internal audit by the office of Pr. CCA.

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6. Compliance of the provisions of OM (F.No.12(13)-B(W&M)/2020) dated 25.05.2022 issued by Budget Division, Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, has been ensured.”.

7. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Wing’s Note No.#249 dated 26.02.2024.

The Section Officer (W&A Section) will be Drawing & Disbursing Officer in connection with the amount sanctioned above. **An amount of ₹1,357.00 crore only (Rupees one thousand three hundred fifty seven crore only)** may be credited in RBI E-Kuber NHAI-CNA Account No.10698001006 - CS-NHAI-SARDP for NER through electronic transfer in favour of National Highways Authority of India (NHAI), New Delhi.


