3. The total RE allocation under EAP JICA Counterpart for the financial year 2024-25 is ₹564.00 Crore. An amount of Rs.564.00 Crore has been allocated/released to NHAI, NHIDCL and State PWDs including the instant proposal for release of Rs.20 Crore. After Release of this allocation of Rs.20 Crore, balance under the head will be nil.

4. It shall be ensured that the expenditure against above sanction is incurred only on the EAP works under JICA entrusted to NHAI by the Ministry.
