- 2. The above expenditure is debitable under Demand No. 85 Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2021-22.
- 3. I am also directed to convey the sanction of the President to allow ROs/RPAOs to admit expenditure against sanctioned LWE Non-TSP works on purely first come first served basis henceforth during 2020-21 out of the total overall allocation of ₹ 80.00 crore for the States/UTs; subject to the condition that office of Principal CCA shall ensure that overall expenditure for LWE Non-TSP is not exceeded at any point of time as these would ensure that bills pertaining to well performing States are cleared without any delay and there is no gestation period involved on account of the requirement to enhance their outlay at any stage in case the States/UTs allocation is/are fully exhausted as long as the total outlay funded by LWE Non-TSP for States/UTs for entire Country is not fully exhausted.

- 4. The works under LWE schemes are to be implemented on the pattern of National Highway Works and Direct Payment Procedure as being adopted for NH works.
- 5. While entertaining the claims on the basis of allocation referred to above, it may please be ensure that:-
 - 1) Expenditure is incurred only on sanctioned works (NHs and State Roads) in LWE affected area only.

2) No claim is entertained for expenditure incurred on any sanctioned works in excess of the sanctioned cost beyond permissible limits.

- 3) No expenditure is admitted on work/portion of the work where it might have been specifically advised not to incur any expenditure pending receipt/approval of certain issues/points, etc.
- 5. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Wing vide their Note No.#92 dated 14.12.2021.
