Subject:- Permission proposal for laying underground water pipe line along the road from Km 13/850 to 15/450(LHS) & Km 15/430 to 17/550(RHS) and across the road at Km 15/430 of NH-383 for providing CWSS to 8 Town Panchayats and 2452 Rural Hanbitations with Buk provision to 3 Municipalities in Sivagangai District with River Cauveery as source (Package III) in the state of Tamil Nadu-Reg.

The proposal is regarding request for permission for laying underground water pipe line along the road from Km 13/850 to 15/450(LHS) & Km 15/430 to 17/550(RHS) and across the road at Km 15/430 of NH-383 for providing CWSS to 8 Town Panchayats and 2452 Rural Hanbitations with Buk provision to 3 Municipalities in Sivagangai District with River Cauveery as source (Package III) in the state of Tamil Nadu by the Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Project Division, Sivagangai submitted to this office by the SE (NH), Madurai vide letter No. 98/2021/JDO/dated 17.03.2022(received on 28.03.2022). The proposal has been examined and the details are as under:

2. The Right of Way in the stretch of NH proposed for laying water pipeline is varying from 13.00m to 24.90m. The carriageway width of stretch from Km 13/850 to 15/450(LHS) & Km 15/430 to 17/550(RHS) of NH- 383 Extn is 10.00m. The Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Project Division, Sivagangai has proposed to lay the underground Utility of NH-383 Extn at edge of the ROW for a length of 5550m by adopting open trench method along the National Highway and HDD method across the National Highway.

3. The Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Project Division, Sivagangai has furnished an undertaking to the effect that they will remove the laid underground water pipe line in future if required by NH wing of State Highways Department, Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India at any time for expansion of the NH at their own cost without claiming any compensation from NH wing of Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India and any right on the NH land. Further, mentioned that, the Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Project Division, Sivagangai will also restore the ROW surfaces to its original condition soon after removal of the Public utility water pipe lines. Also, certified that the proposed underground water pipeline work will not affect the design, stability, traffic safety and future improvement of the proposed stretch.
