**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the 14th November, 2008

**S.O. 2663(E).** – In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (2) of Section 2 of the National Highways Act, 1956 (48 of 1956), the Central Government hereby declares each of the Highways specified in the columns (3) of the Table below to be a National Highway.

The said highways, now declared to be National Highways, shall be deemed to be specified in the Schedule to the said Act with the corresponding serial number, National Highway number and the description thereof indicated in the said Table.

117A	Extension of NH-226	The highway starting from Perambalur connecting Perali, Keelapalur, Ariyalur, Kunnam, Thiruvaijuru, Kandiyur and joining NH-226 at Thanjavur in the State of Tamil Nadu.
121	230	The highway starting from Madurai connecting Tiruppuvanam, Poovandhi, Sivaganga, Kalaiyarkoil, Tiruvadanai and terminating at Tondi Port town in the State of Tamil Nadu.
3BA	Extension of NH-2B	The highway starting from Bolpur connecting Prantik, Mayureswar and terminating at Mollapur at the junction of NH-60 in the State of West Bengal.
