NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 2 of the **National Highways Act, 1956** (48 of 1956), the Central Government hereby declares the highways specified in the Table below to be national highways :

(Supplement to Schedule to the National Highways Act, 1956 — No. 48 of 1956)

Serial No.	National Highway No.	Description of national highways
5A	4A	The highway connecting Belgaum, Anmod, Ponda and Panaji.
6A	5A	The highway starting from its junction near Haridaspur with N.H. No. 5 and terminating at the Paradip Port.
13D	21	The highway starting from its junction near Chandigarh with the N.H. No. 22 and connecting Rupar, Bilaspur, Mandi, Kulu and Manali.
27A	36	The highway connecting Nowgong Dabaka and Dimapur (Manipur Road)
33A	44	The highway connecting Shillong, Passi, Badarpur and Agartala.
