Sir,

In view of the huge investments being made in the roads sector, skill development in this sector is very critical to achieve the objectives. Thus, it is high time to:

- Train the construction workforce to meet the challenges and demand for world class construction skills in terms of safety, quality and productivity.
- Identify the training needs of the construction workforce and set standards to monitor their occupational competencies and technical skills deployed in the industry.

2. The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has issued Policy Circular No RW/NH-33044/10/2021-S&R (P&B) dated 05th April, 2023 regarding Skill Development of Workmen in the Highways Construction Sector, copy of which is enclosed for ready reference. To make the skill development Programme meet the scale and quality standards, it is requested to submit the requirement of the skilled manpower in numbers of different trades such as Bar Bender & Steel Fixer, Mason, Foreman Concrete, Shuttering Carpenter, Construction Laboratory and Field Technician, Assistant Surveyor, Assistant Technician - Prestress, Pavement Layer Helper, Fabrication, Gas Cutter, Rigger Piling Construction, Welder (Electives: MIG/TIG/SAW), Advance Masonry, Tiling & Stonework, Construction Electrician, Industrial Electrician, Formwork & Carpentry, Scaffolding, Structural Welding, Pipe Welding, Pipe Fitting (Mech), Plumbing, Pipe Fitting (Civil - Water Supply Main), Lab Technician - Building, Lab Technician - Roads, Survey - Civil Works, Solar Technician Pre-Stressed Technician, Roller Operator, Grader Operator, Paver Operator, Auto Electrician, CCTV Operation & Maintenance, OFC Operation & Maintenance, O&M - Electrical & Mechanical etc. or in any specialized area with the contractors working on National Highways.

Subject: Skill Development of Workmen in the Highways Construction Sector regarding.

Ref: Ministry's circular no. RW/NH-11065/2/2017-P&M (Mon) dated 02.08.2019.

Madam/Sir,

Ministry vide referred circular has issued guidelines regarding the Skill Development of Workmen in the Highways Construction Sector. The skill development programme was discontinued during COVID-19 pandemic. It has now been decided to re-start skill development programme from the year 2023-24 in National Highways projects with civil construction cost of Rs. 200 crore and above.

2. The skill development programme shall be conducted in accordance with Ministry's circular under reference with following modifications:

2.1 Number of participants in one training programme shall be between 25 and 35.

2.2 Following training programmes may be conducted depending on local demand and availability of workmen. The course duration and amount to be paid to training provider per hour are indicated therein:

2.3 Assessor will be paid assessment fee of Rs. 1200 per candidate.


