Subject: Use of Language on Kilometre Stones and Signboards on National Highways

Please refer to Ministry's circular No. NH-III/P/24/76 dated the 16th June, 1981 wherein Ministry's policy guidelines on the language to be used in inscribing the kilometre stones and signboards on National Highways have been enunciated.

All the executing agencies are requested to review the position and deficiency if any, may be rectified in time bound manner to ensure that three language formulate (i.e. English, Hindi and Language of the State concerned) is being followed strictly in inscribing kilometre stones and signboards on National Highways in accordance to the Ministry's guidelines issued vide circular dated the 16th June, 1981.
