
Subject :- Circular/Notification for reverting land, which is no longer required for development of National Highways, back to States. – regarding

Sir,

I am directed to say that during the Senior Officers meeting held on 4-11-2013 the matter regarding reverting land no longer required for development of National Highways, back to State was discussed. It was observed that there is no such provision in NH Act 1956, NH Rules 1957 and the Control of NH (Land and Traffic Act 2002), which mention about the surplus land and the process of reverting it back to the States. Since the Control of NH (Land and Traffic Act 2002) does not extensively about the use of National Highway, this Ministry is considering for bringing an amendment in the Act so that the surplus land can be reverted back to the States.

2. You are requested to furnish the comments of NHAI in this regard at the earliest.
