This is with reference to the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the appointment of consultancy services for the preparation of Detailed Project Reports (DPR) concerning National Highways (NH) and Centrally Sponsored Road Works, which specifies the mandatory training course requirement for key personnel involved in DPR preparation.

2. Training for key personnel of the DPR is of utmost importance to bridge the professional gap and acts as both a refresher and an opportunity to stay updated with the latest developments and best practices. This ensures that the team is equipped with current knowledge, enhancing their effectiveness. However, officers, who have superannuated in the last 5 years at the level of Chief Engineers (CEs) and above, from the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH), State PWDs, Border Road Organisation, Chief General Manager, National Highway Authority of India(NHAI), possess substantial experience in construction and maintenance of road/highway projects are exempted from

the mandatory training course conducted by the Indian Academy of Highway Engineers (IAHE) or any other institute for DPR key personnel.
