The Chief Engineer, NH, Bengaluru vide letter cited under reference above (Annexure I), has submitted proposal seeking permission for laying of laying of water supply line from Km 214.150 to 226.300 (RHS) (from Nanjappa life care bridge to Ayanoor circle), from Km 230.400 to Km 231.400 (LHS), from km 231.400 to 232.800 (RHS) (near Chikkadanavandi cross to Kumsi railway gate) and crossings at Km 214.150, Km 226.300 , Km 231.400 by M/s. Karnataka Niravari Nigama Ltd. Shimoga.

Sub: Proposal for ROW permission for laying Water Supply pipe line at Km 214.15 to Km 226.30 in RHS (from Nanjappa life care bridge to Ayanoor circle) and Km 230.400 to Km 232.800 in RHS (from near Chikkadanandi Cross to Kusmi railway gate) of NH-206 and crossing at Km 214.15, 226.30 and 230.00 of NH-206 Tumkur –Honnavar Section between for granting permission– Reg.

Adverting to the above subject, the Superintending Engineer N.H circle, Bangalore has submitted the as proposal received from Assistant Executive Engineer, UTP Sub-Division, KNNL, Shimoga, requesting ROW permission for laying Water Supply pipe line at Km 214.15 to Km 226.30 in RHS (from Nanjappa life care bridge to Ayanoor circle) and Km 230.400 to Km 232.800 in RHS (from near Chikkadanandi Cross to Kusmi railway gate) of NH-206 and crossing at Km 214.15, 226.30 and 230.00 of NH-206 Tumkur –Honnavar Section.

It is reported that the site has been inspected by the Executive Engineer, NHD Shimogga and the proposed reach is having a carriageway width of 22.50 mtrs and 15.00 mtrs. It is proposed to lay MS water supply pipe line at 214.15 to Km 226.300 on RHS (Nanjappa life care bridge to Ayanoor circle) and again from Km 230.400 to Km 232.800 in RHS (from near Chikkadanandi Cross to Kusmi railway gate) along NH-206. It is proposed to lay 1200 mm dia pipe & NH-206 respectively.

The proposal received from the Superintending Engineer N.H circle, Bangalore has been examined with respect to Ministry's, letter No. Rw/NH-33044/29/2015/S&R (R) date:22.11.2016 for accommodation of Public and Industrial utility services along and across National Highways and found generally in order. The necessary undertaking, along with the strip plan indicating the proposed pipelines are also enclosed. Assessment of land value is attached with the proposal.

The request of the Assistant Executive Engineer, UTP Sub-Division, KNNL, Shimoga, is recommended for approval, subject to the following conditions.

- 1. The applicant has to furnish the License deed duly signing the agreement for the use of NH land as per Ministry's guidelines along with the required Bank Guarantee/Performance guarantee.
- 2. The trenches to be opened for a short length of 200mts, the pipe line should be laid and refilled properly and then only further trenching will be allowed. The refilled trenches are to be compacted properly with plate compactor or rollers to the original density.
- 3. Water Supply pipe line shall be laid at the extreme edge of the available ROW along the corridor provided along highway to depth not less than 1.75 mtrs from road surface/ground level.
- 4. The trenches to be opened for a short length of 200 mtrs, the pipe line should be laid and refilled properly immediately and then only further trending will be allowed. The refilled trenches are to be compacted properly with plate compactor or rollers to the original density.
- 5. Trenching should not be done during monsoon.
- 6. Under any circumstances highway structures should not be damaged.
- 7. The trench should properly be restored to the original condition.
- 8. The MS Water Supply pipe line will have to be shifted by the applicant without any claim and without damaging National Highway property in case the road is widened or reconstructed.
- 9. This department is not responsible for any damages, which are likely to occur to the MS Water Supply pipe line caused during maintenance or any other nature of works to be carried out in National Highway land.
- 10. If the MS Water Supply pipe line is to be laid along the drain it should be refilled with concrete and original drain may be restored for the free flow of rain water.
- 11. While passing the MS Water Supply pipe line along the culverts and bridges if any, it should be taken outside the structure without abutting to it with necessary arrangements.
- 12. It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to take all preventive measures to avoid likely damages to the existing cables, water supply pipe lines etc., This department is not responsible for any consequences in this matter
- 13. All safety measures like display of work in progress board, cautionary boards and barricading etc., should be strictly followed as per the guidelines of MORTH norms during the execution of the work.

As per Ministry letter under reference (2) above, the approval has to be accorded with prior permission of MoRTH.

Hence while enclosing the proposal, it is requested to communicate approval early.
