Invitation of public comments

Subject:- Permission proposal for laying underground “City Gas Distribution (CGD)” pipeline along the National Highways from Km 4/195 to 7/340(LHS) of NH-381(Tiruppur-Avinashi Highway) in the state of Tamil Nadu -Regarding.

The proposal is regarding request for permission for laying underground “City Gas Distribution (CGD)” pipeline along the National Highways from Km 4/195 to 7/340(LHS) of NH-381(Tiruppur-Avinashi Highway) in the state of Tamil Nadu by M/s Adani Gas Ltd., resubmitted to this office by the SE (NH), Salem vide letter No. 128/2020/JDO/NH/dated 29.04.2022(received on 09.05.2022). The proposal has been examined and the details are as under:

2. The Right of Way in the stretch of NH proposed for laying underground “City Gas Distribution (CGD)” pipeline is varying from 25.00m to 37.20m. The carriageway width of stretch from Km 4/195 to 7/340(LHS) of NH-381 is varies from 17.27 to 26.11m. M/s Adani Gas Ltd., has proposed to lay the underground Public Utility at edge of the ROW for a length of 3145m by adopting trenchless method (HDD) along the National Highways.


3. M/s Adani Gas Ltd., has furnished an undertaking to the effect that they will remove the laid Public Utility Gas pipeline in future if required by NH wing of State Highways Department, Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India at any time for expansion of the NH at their own cost without claiming any compensation from NH wing of Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India and any right on the NH land. Further, mentioned that, the by M/s Adani Gas Ltd., will also restore the ROW surfaces to its original condition soon after removal of the Public utility Gas pipelines. Also, certified that the proposed Public Utility work will not affect the design, stability, traffic safety and future improvement of the proposed stretch.

4. As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No.RW/NH-33044/29/2015/ S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016 the application will be made available for public comments and the comments will be invited within 30 days from the day of uploading the same in the web site of Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for public comments.
