Invitation of public comments

**Subject:-** Permission proposal for laying 500mm dia DI underground water supply pipe road cross by trenchless method at Km 287/015 of HN-948( Bangaluru- Sathyamangalam Coimbatore road) in Coimbatore district in the state of Tamil Nadu-under combined water supply implement scheme to the 107 Habitats in Avinashi union and bulk supply to 165 habitation in Tiruppur union in Tiruppur district with new source package III-Reg.

The proposal is regarding request for permission for laying 500mm dia DI underground water supply pipe road cross by trenchless method at Km 287/015 of HN-948( Bangaluru- Sathyamangalam Coimbatore road) in Coimbatore district in the state of Tamil Nadu by the Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Major Project division Coimbatore submitted to this office by the SE (NH), Salem vide letter No. 801/2022/JDO/NH/ dated 08.04.2022. The proposal has been examined and the details are as under:

2. The Right of Way in the stretch of NH proposed for laying underground water pipe line is 27.00m. The carriageway width of stretch at Km.287/015 of NH-948 is 7.00m. The Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Major Project division, Coimbatore has proposed to lay the underground 500mm dia DI water supply pipe line across at Km 287/015 for a length of 28m by adopting trenchless method across the National Highway.


3. The Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Major Project Division, Coimbatore, has furnished an undertaking to the effect that they will remove the laid underground water pipe line in future if required by NH wing of State Highways Department, Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India at any time for expansion of the NH at their own cost without claiming any compensation from NH wing of Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India and any right on the NH land. Further, mentioned that, the Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, Major Project Division, Coimbatore will also restore the ROW surfaces to its original condition soon after removal of the Public utility water pipe lines. Also, certified that the proposed underground water pipeline work will not affect the design, stability, traffic safety and future improvement of the proposed stretch.

4. As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No. RW/NH-33044/29/2015/ S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016 the application will be made available for public comments and the comments will be invited within 30 days from the day of uploading the same in the web site of Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for public comments.
