**Invitation of Public Comments**

**Sub:- Issue of access permission for construction of an approach road to the proposed new Petrol/diesel retail outlet in Re-Survey No.191/8-9, 8-15, 8-29, 8-50, 8-55, 7-25, 4/45, 2B-15 of Thazhekodde Village, Perinthalmanna Taluk, Malappuram District at Km.82/065(LHS) on NH-966 of Kerala State by M/s Nayara Energy Ltd-reg.**

The Executive Engineer NH Division Malappuram's letter No.A3/Access/217/Outlet/2017 dated 04.11.2019 has submitted proposal for the access permission for construction of an approach road to the proposed new Petrol/Diesel retail Outlet in Re-Survey No.191/8-9, 8-15, 8-29, 8-50, 8-55, 7-25, 4/45, 2B-15 of Thazhekodde Village, Perinthalmanna Taluk, Malappuram District at Km.82/065(LHS) on NH-966 in the State of Kerala. Further Executive Engineer NH Division, Malappuram vide letter dated 16.12.2019 has reported that a intersection road having 3.50 M width exists at a distance of 70 M from proposed retail outlet site. The Proposal has been examined and observed that the proposal required relaxation of ministry's norms. The Oil company vide letter dated 17.12.2019 has requested for relaxation of norms.

2. As per guideline issued by Ministry vide letter O.M. No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO III dated 16.03.2016 according to which for relaxation cases the Highway Administrator will make available in Ministry website the complete application for public comments and comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form 'A'.

As per proposal due to following the relaxation is sought by applicant.


Sl.No	Relaxation Category	Justification by applicant
1)	Intersection with roads of carriageway width 3.5M At distance of 70M from the Proposed Fuel Station against 100M stipulated in Ministry Guideline.	The Existing road is at 70M After the proposed RO Location and it is used as an entry and exit of few residential houses having a dead end at 90M. With the construction of Service road by the Oil Company (at their own cost), there will be no hindrance to the traffic on main carriageway due to the entry or exit of vehicles to the proposed outlet.


