The GM (Tech), UP(E) NHAI, Varanasi, vide letter no. 14011/42/UP(E)/2017/1627 dated 11.05.2018 has submitted a proposal for access permission with respect of fuel station mentioned in

- 2. From the drawings submitted with the proposal, it is seen that there exist a 3.0m wide Kharanja road at a distance of 55m towards Barabanki side and another 3.0m wide Kharanja road at a distance of 80m opposite towards Bahraich side from the proposed fuel station. As per Ministry's guidelines dated 24.07.2013, para 4.5.1 (ii), no intersection with rural roads/approach roads to private & public properties should exist within 300m on either side of proposed fuel station.
- 2.1 The Oil Company has requested for relaxation in view of para 2 above. The reasons for relaxation as recommended by GM (Tech), UP(E) NHAI, Varanasi, are as follows:
- (i) The Oil Company has proposed to construct a 5.5m wide and 850m long service road including deceleration and acceleration lane with separator covering intersection at applicant own cost.
- (ii) There exists 3.0m wide kharanja road at a distance of 55m towards Barabanki side from the proposed fuel station site which terminates at field. Another 3.0m wide kharanja road at a distance of 185m towards Bahraich side from the proposed fuel station site which terminates at Ghat (River Bank).
- (iii) Only cyclists/motor cyclist & pedestrians use these kharanja roads. No LMV/heavy vehicles ply on these roads. Therefore, there is minimum traffic on these roads without disturbing NH traffic.
- (iv) The applicant would provide all safety devices as required.
- 3. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments in Ministry's website thereby bringing out the relaxation sought by the applicant. Comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
